□ 8:00-8:45am - Your Role in the One Call Process

PA Act 287, as amended, involves a multitude of stakeholders including project owners, designers, excavators, and underground facility owners and operators. Each have a shared responsibility to work safely around the infrastructure. In order to do so, stakeholders must be aware of their obligations under PA Act 287. This session gives you a better understanding of how the "one call cycle" works and how all stakeholders have an obligation to work together to ensure the safety of the project, community and those involved. 9:00–9:45am - Coordinate PA

Learn how to utilize the Pennsylvania 811 Coordinate PA application for all of your notifications from conception to construction. Use Coordinate PA to create design, complex project, and excavation notifications to increase project safety and reduce project costs as required by Pennsylvania's Underground Utility Line Protection law. **It is required to use Coordinate PA for all complex projects and design notifications*. 9:00–9:45am - Construction Confined Space

Construction sites and authority facilities often have confined spaces that can pose a serious hazard to employees who are not properly trained. It is important for workers to understand the statistics and real-life examples of confined space studies in order to fully grasp the potential dangers. A review of the OSHA regulations, as well as equipment options including inspection breakdowns, will be discussed. Key points such as the importance of written confined space programs and the necessity of air monitoring and rescue plans will also be addressed. Presented by: Monica Rakoczy, EnterTRAINING. 

□ 10:00-10:45am - Subsurface Utility Engineering Overview In 2022, the American Society of Civil Engineers, Utility Engineering & Surveying, and the Construction Institute aka ASCE/UESI/CI adopted the new Subsurface Utility Engineering (SUE) Standard of Care Guidelines for Investigating and Documenting Existing Utilities ASCE 38-22 and for Recording and Exchanging Utility Infrastructure Data ASCE 75-22. This session is an overview of the SUE and Pennsylvania 811 processes for Project Owners' and Designers' responsibilities under PA Act 287, as amended, and will detail how the use of the SUE process will save on construction costs and minimize damages during construction.
