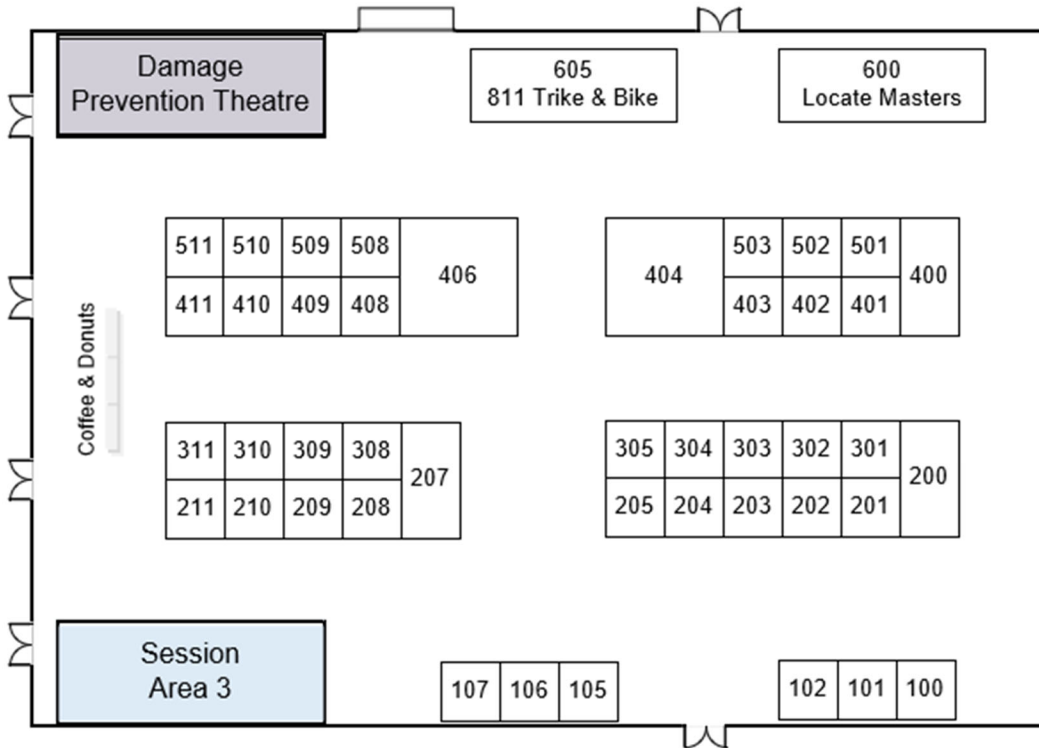

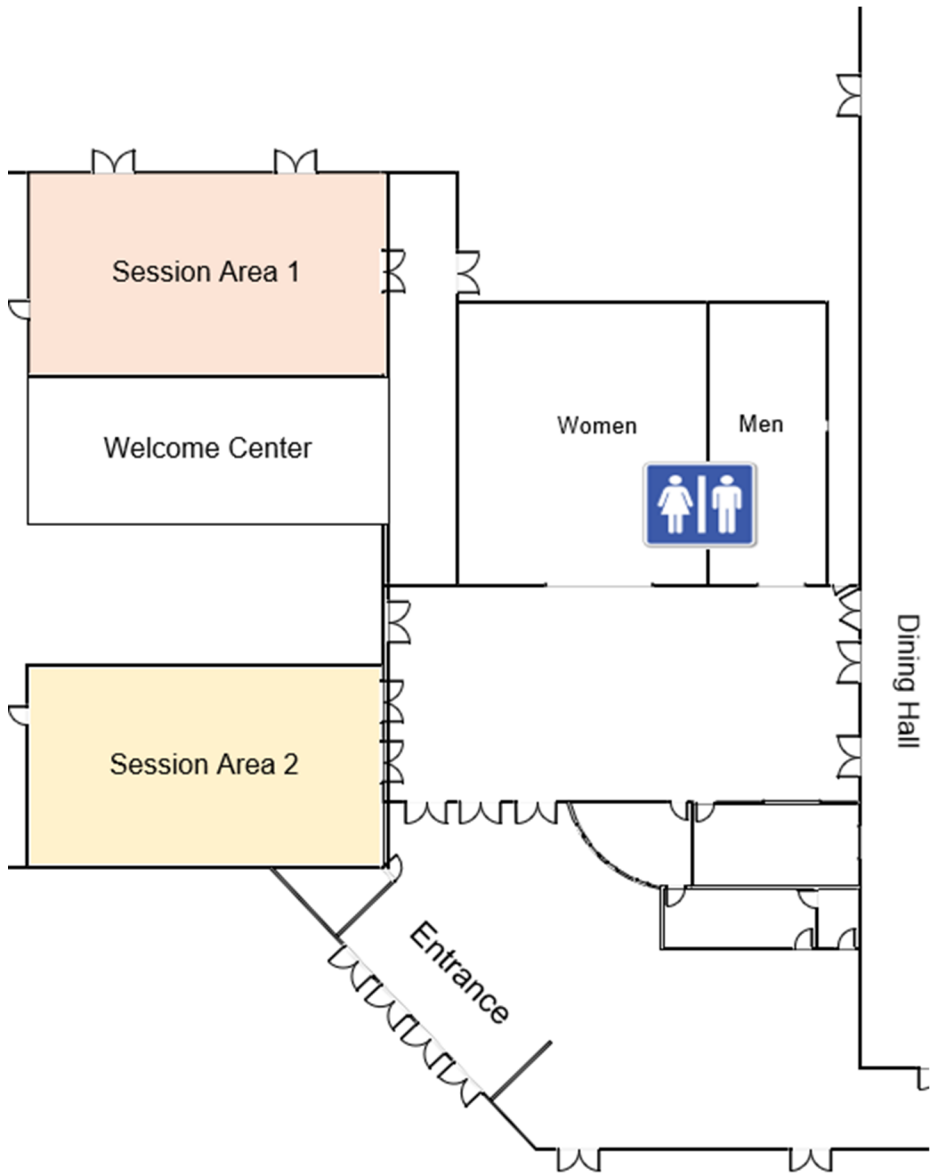

Use Coordinate PA to create design, complex project, and excavation notifications to increase project safety and reduce project costs as required by Pennsylvania's Underground Utility Line Protection law. **It is required to use Coordinate PA for all complex projects and design notifications.*

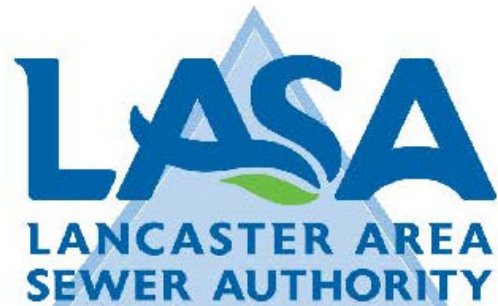
